Carpet and Padding for large areas MUST BE CUT into smaller pieces (4'x6') for disposal in the compactor. Rolls of cut carpet or padding are placed in the compactor area and should not be more than 5-6 feet in length. Please pay attention to how wide the carpet/padding roll so that they remain easily handled by operator. DO NOT – Roll Carpet and Padding Together

## Information on LARGE carpet disposal:

MCSWC will accept large carpets or padding rolls that are *larger than* 4'x6' up to 12' in length in the landfill area transfer station roll-off bin. Single carpets or padding greater than 12' in length <u>MUST BE</u> <u>CUT</u> into smaller pieces (at minimum – in half). In addition, please pay attention to how wide the carpet/padding roll so that they remain easily handled by operator or machinery. **DO NOT** – Roll Carpet and Padding Together
